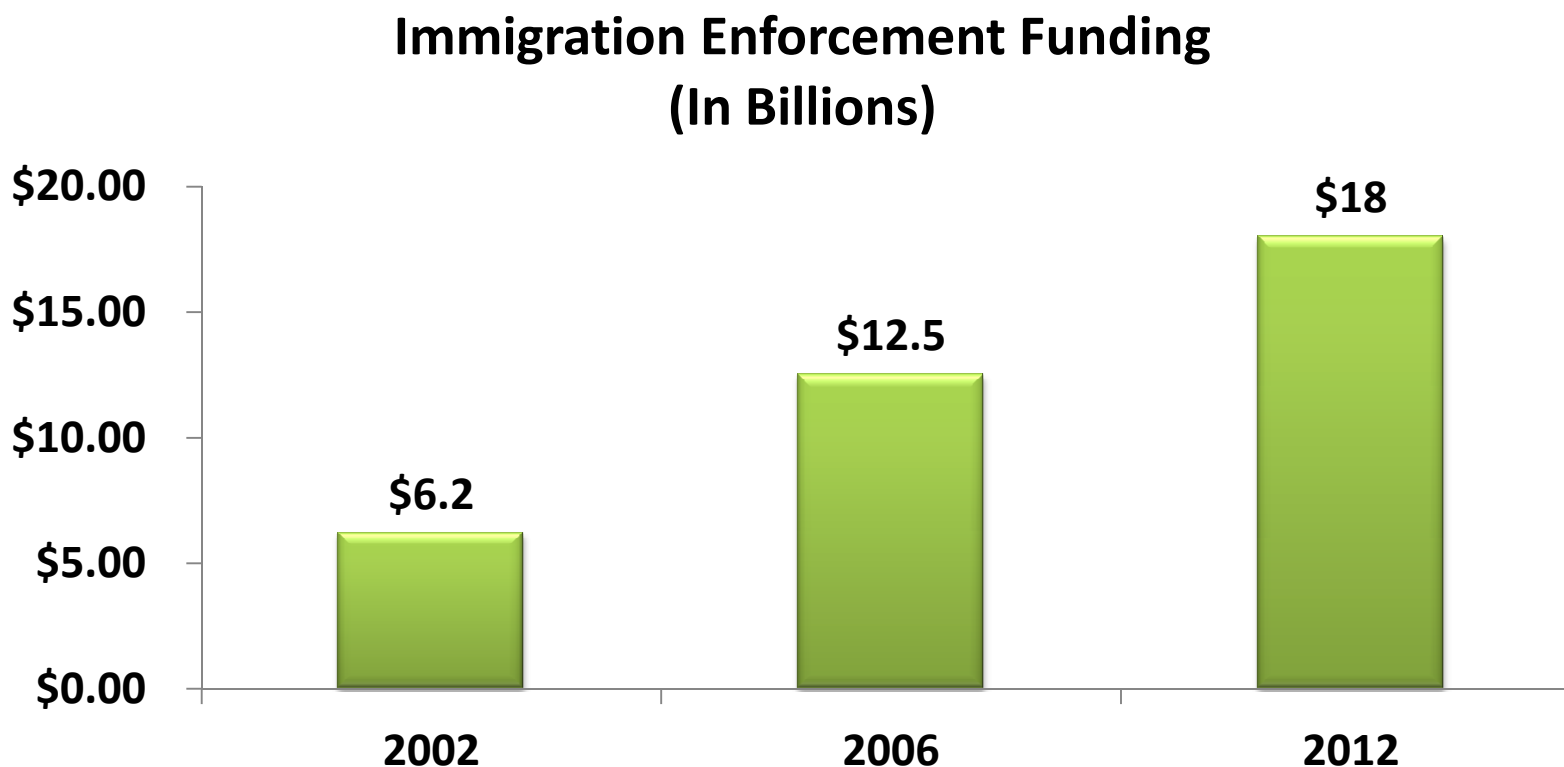

The Border Is Safer

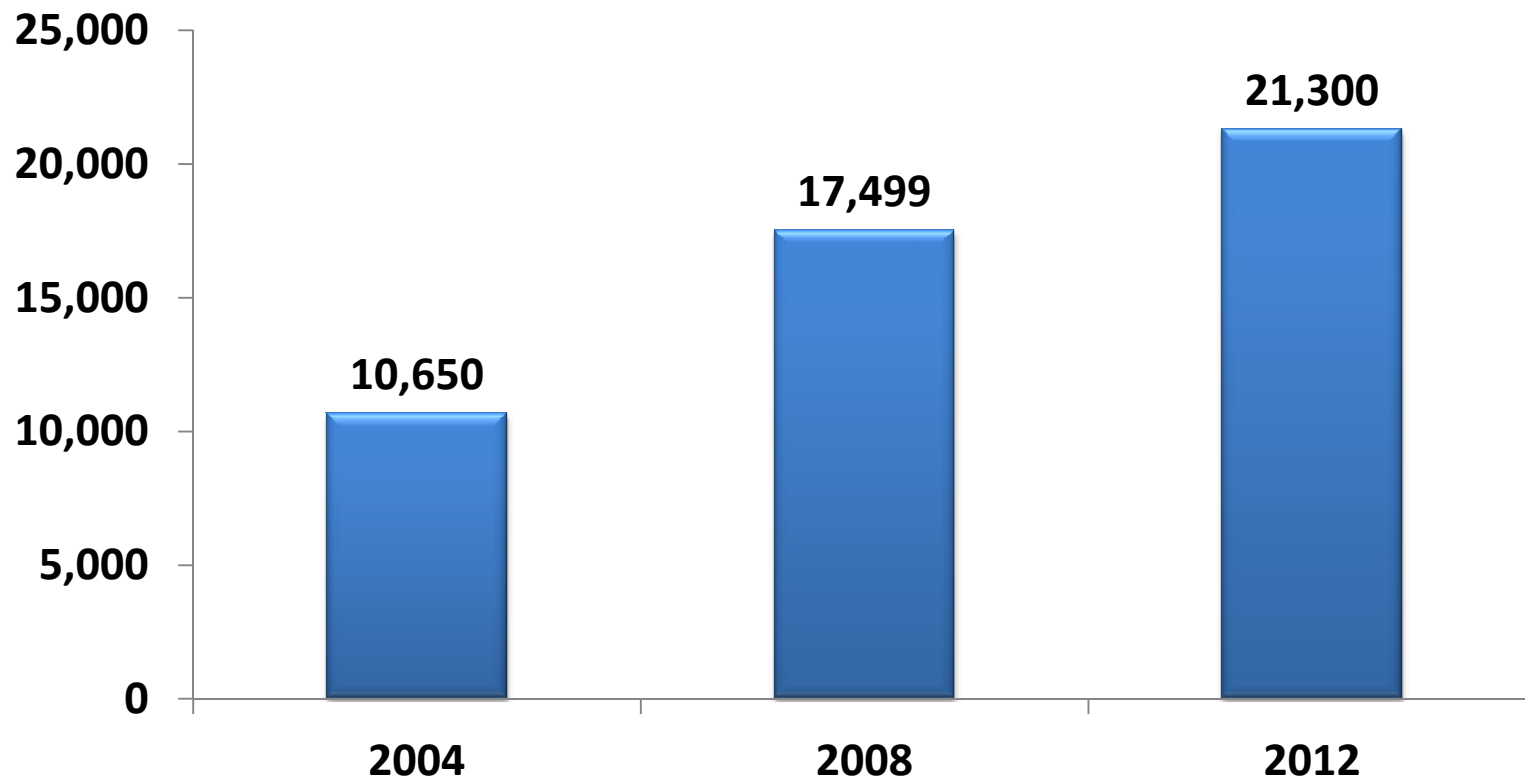
Since 2002, Enforcement Budget Has Tripled



Between FY 2002-2006, funding for CBP, ICE, and U.S. VISIT more than doubled from 6.2 Billion to \$12.5 billion by 2012 that number had increased another 43%

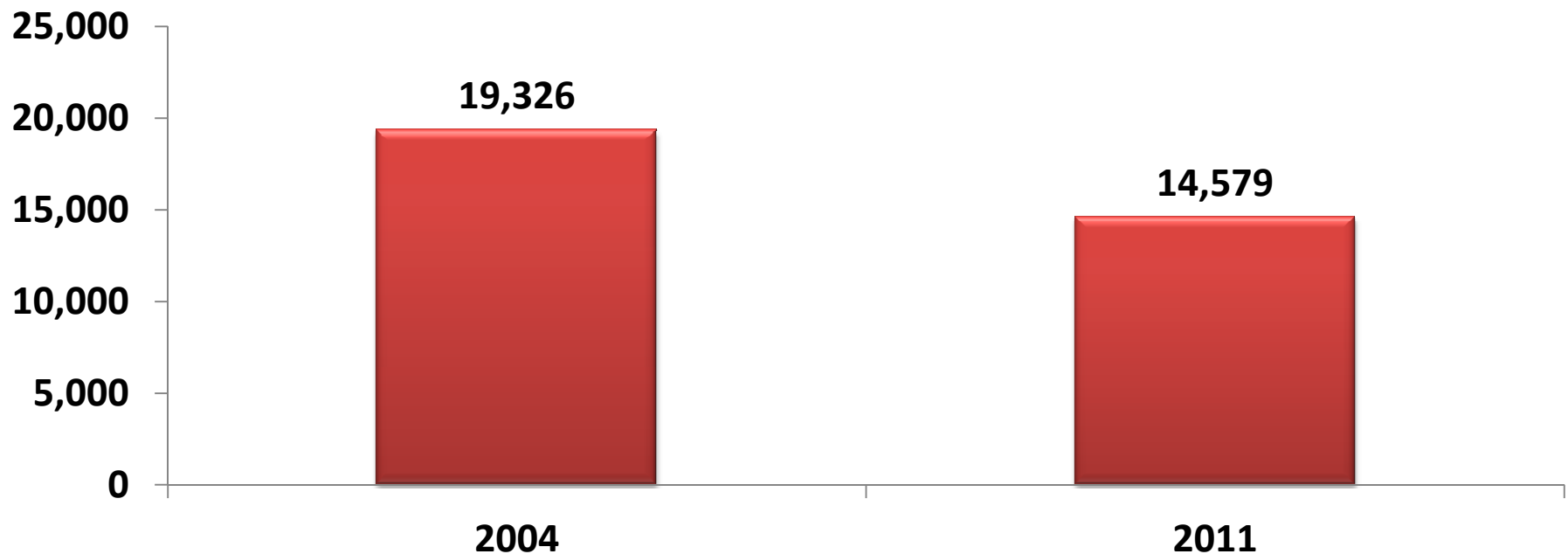
Number of “Boots on The Ground” Has Doubled

Border Patrol Agents



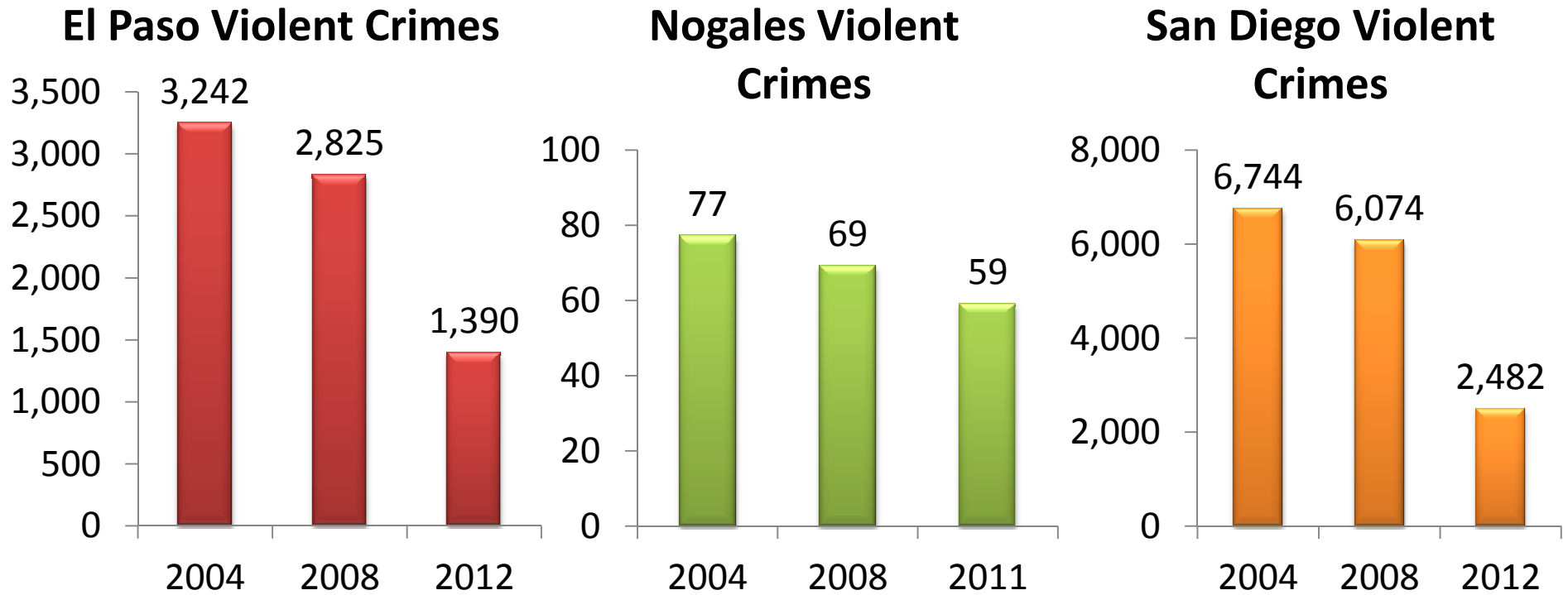
And It Has Worked - Crime on U.S. Side of the Border Has Plummeted

Incidents of Violent Crime Along Border *



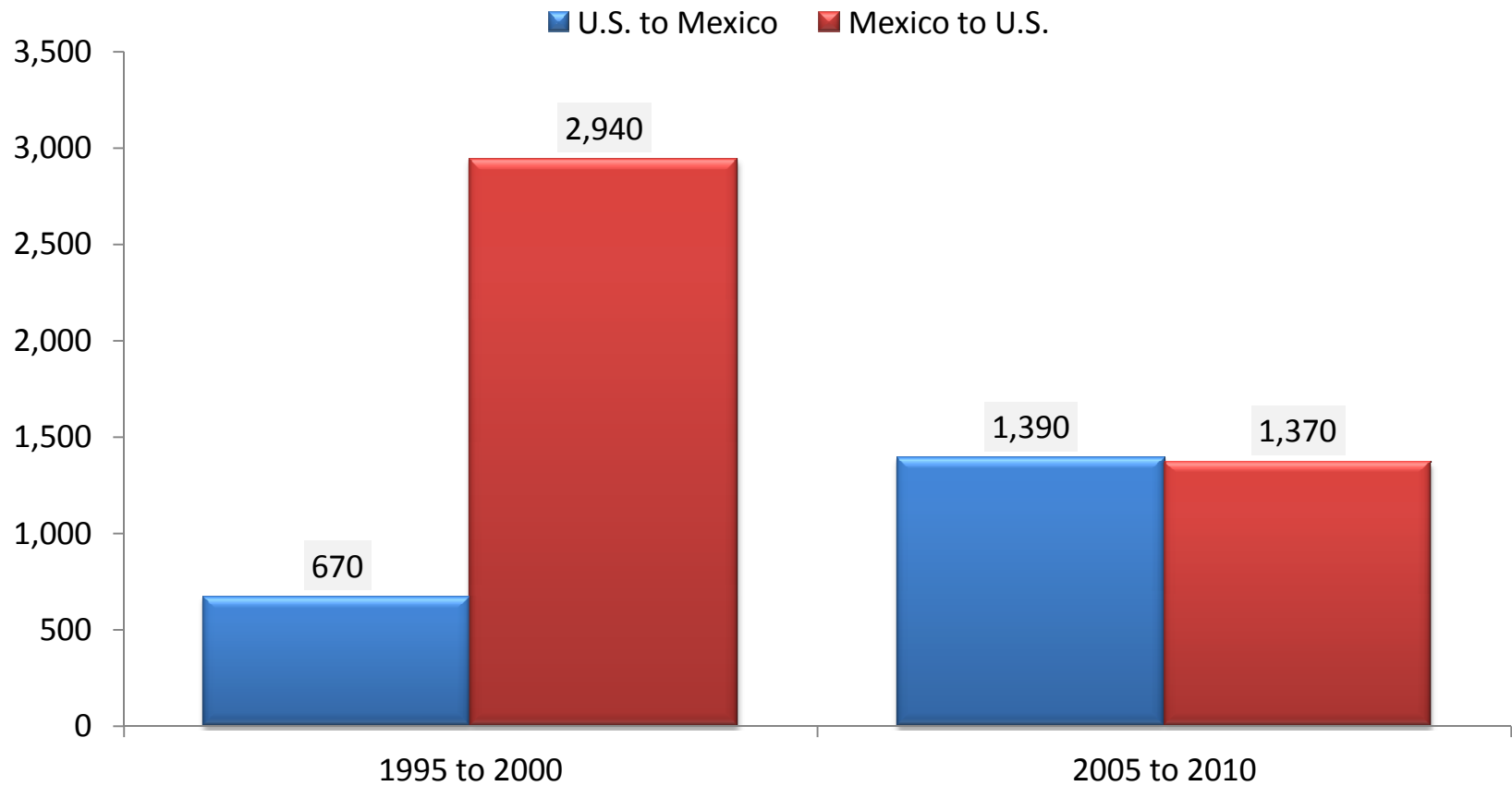

Administration Has Used Its Legal Authority To Make Significant Improvements In the System

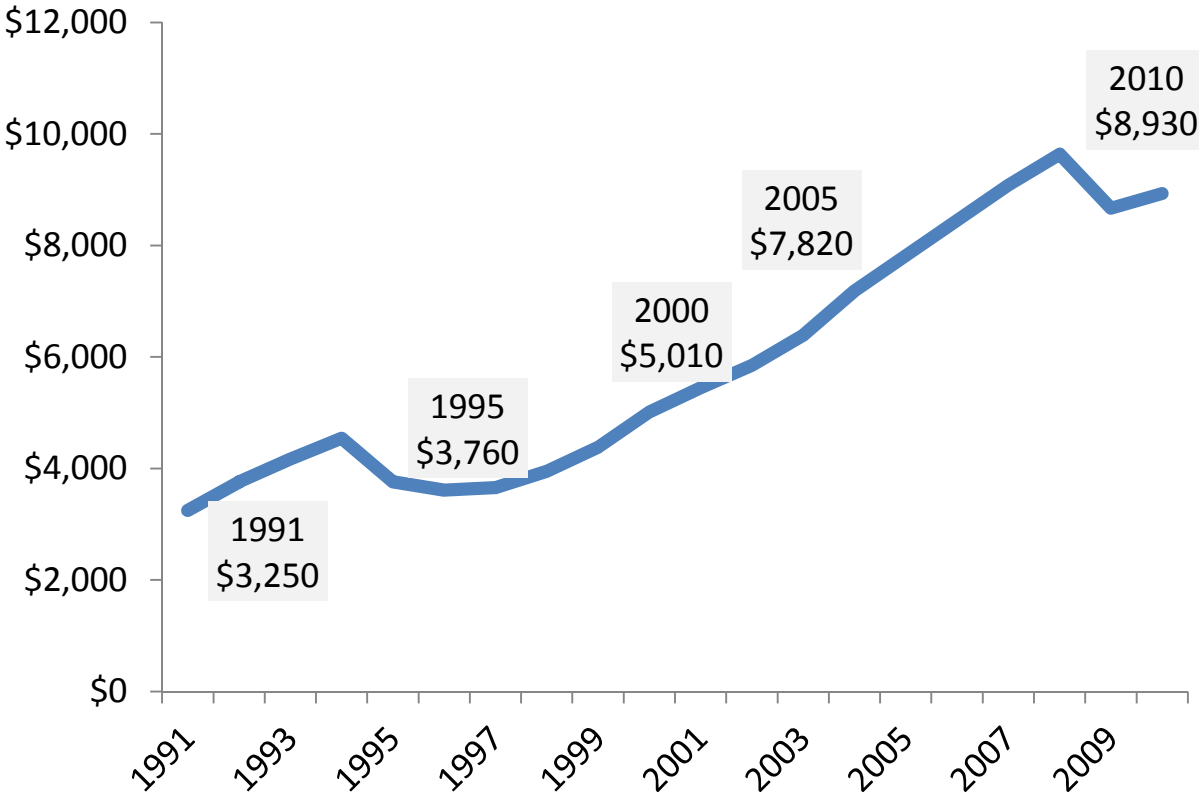
- Replaced work place raids with more targeted and effective I-9 audits

- Prioritized criminal migrants for deportation
- Implemented Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DREAM Youth)
- Is doing away with the 3-10 year bar, allowing more families to stay together during the legal immigration process



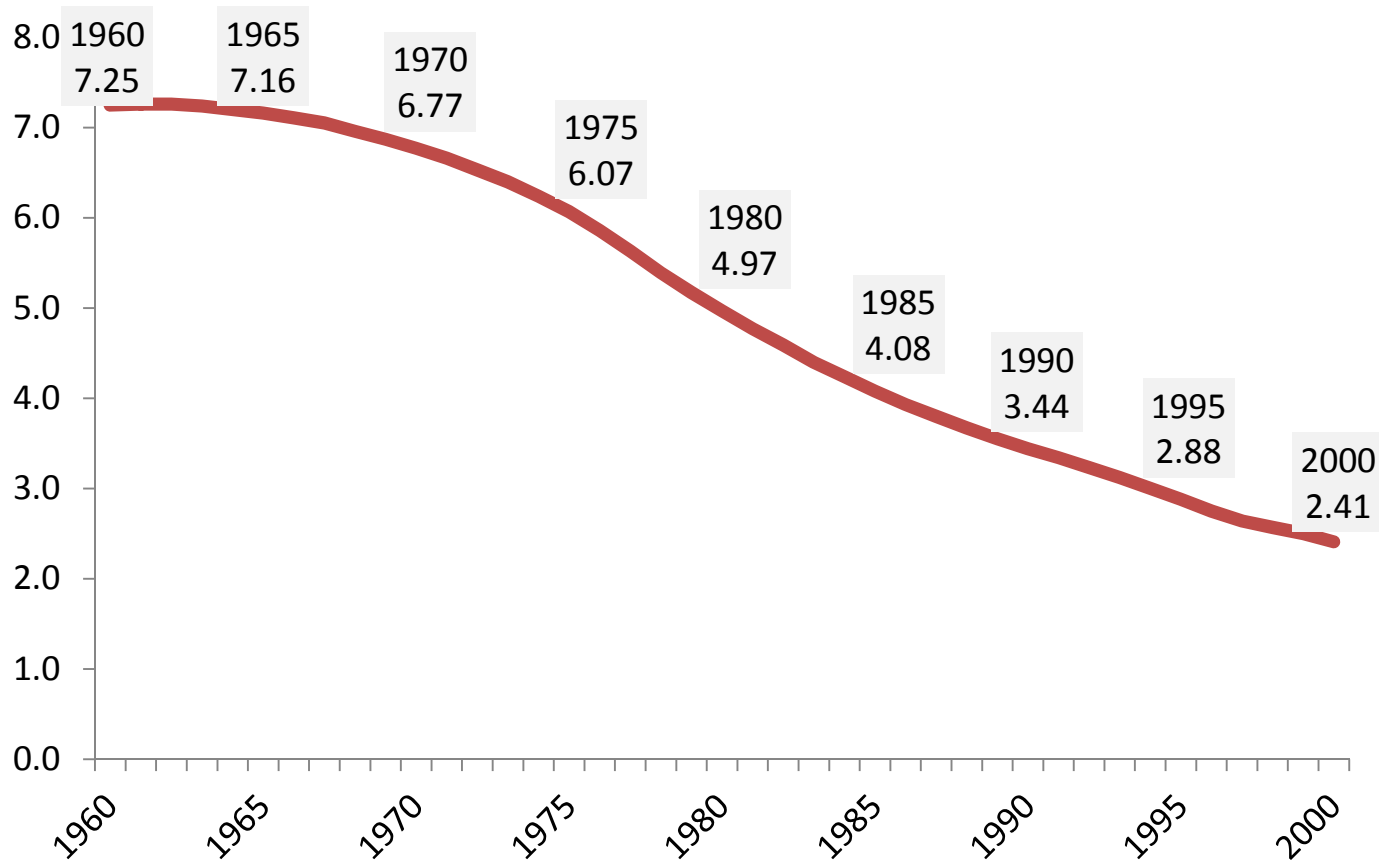

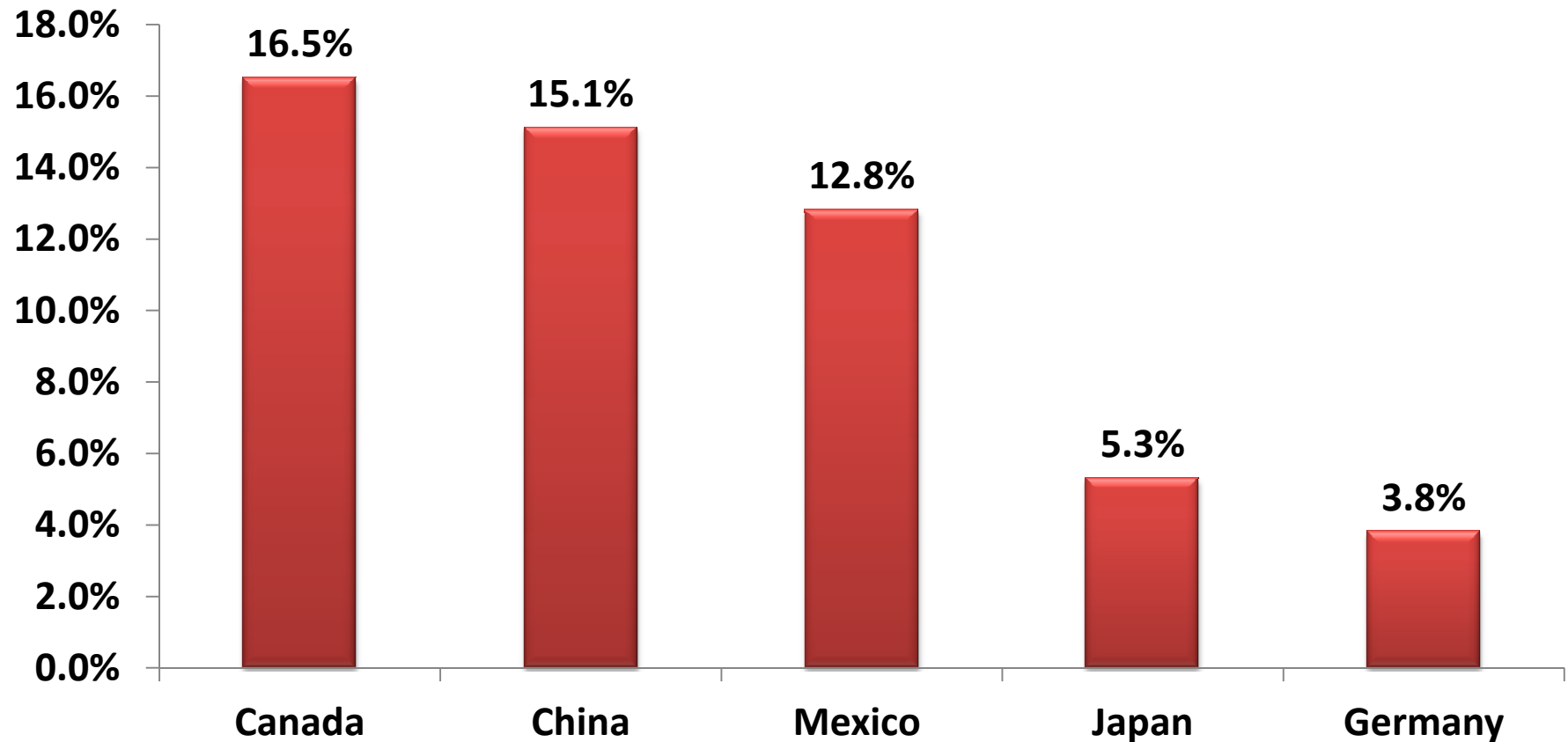
Mexico Is Rapidly Becoming A Middle Class Country



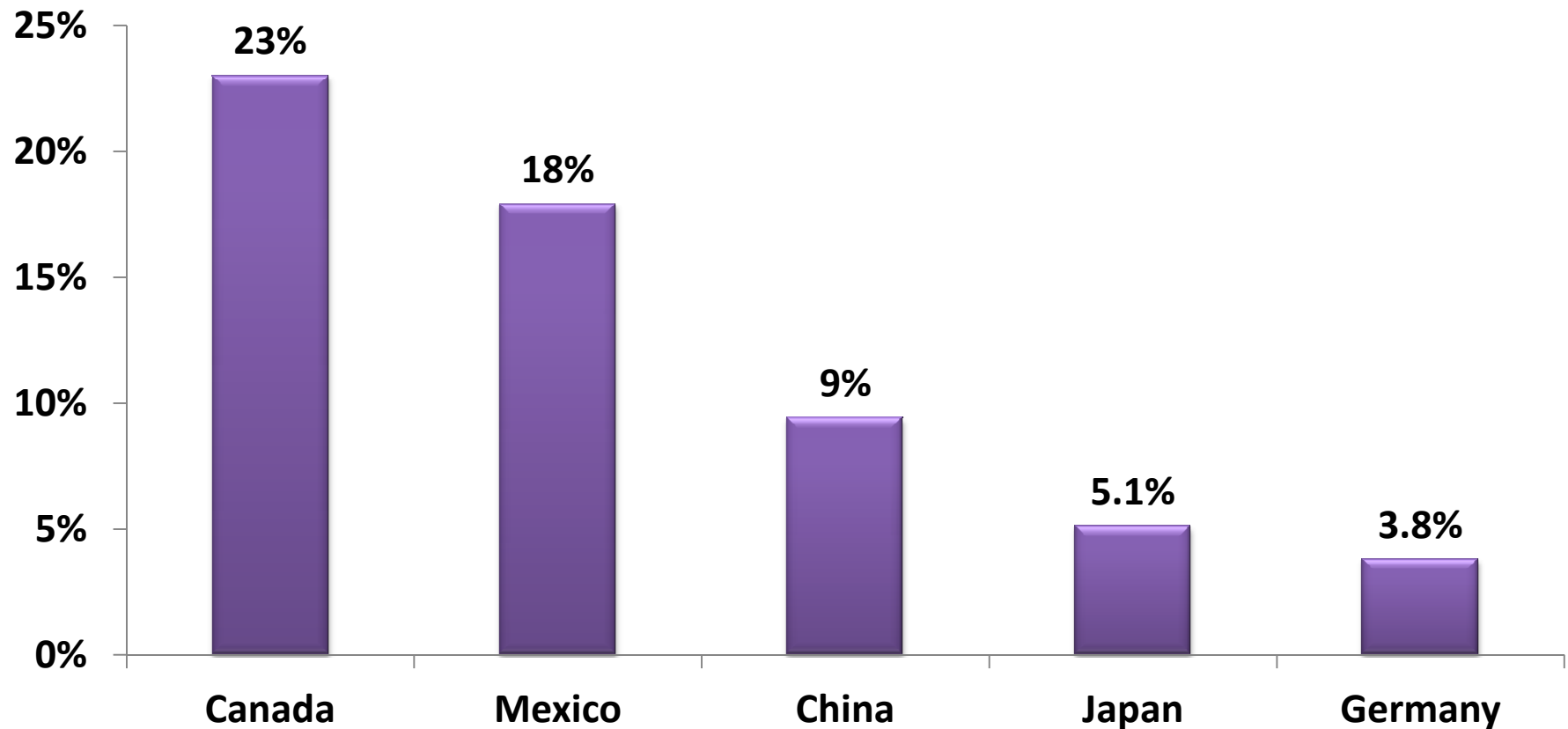
Smaller Families Have Led To Less Migration
